Reflection

Reflection is a time of calm thought and consideration. It is a time when you are able to think about the things we have talked about in Collective Worship and relate these to how you live your life.





Theme: New beginnings – Hopes and fears

Theme: Wisdom – living wisely

Theme: Creation – celebrating God's goodness

Genesis 1:27-30

²⁷So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. ²⁸God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground." ²⁹Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food. 30 And to all the beasts of the earth and all the birds in the sky and all the creatures that move along the ground-everything that has the breath of life in it-I give every green plant for food." And it was so.



Theme: Harvest and thankfulness

Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds.
