Dear Parents / Carers,

Happy New Year.

Shortly you will be receiving your child's interim report. I am very grateful to the hundred or so parents who came out last night to be briefed on the rationale behind these reports. As I guess most of you will know by now the government disbanded the previous assessment system in which pupils were given levels depending on their attainment. The government stated that levels had become confusing to parents and that pupils were being rushed between levels rather than properly developing the skills that they needed at each stage.

In the light of this we have worked very closely with Wimborne Academy Trust schools and with Queen Elizabeth School and their partner middle schools to produce a report which you can use as a discussion starter with your child and with your child's teachers. To that end parents evenings will follow shortly after the release of the report and I invite you put in your diary Wednesday 20th January between 6pm - 8.30pm and Thursday 28th January between 3.30pm - 6pm. As in previous years these spring term parents evenings will be subject-based giving you the chance to speak to your child's specific teacher for certain subjects.

There will be more detail about the format of the reports in the report documents but the focus, as indicated, is about your child's approach to their learning and whether or not they're making the progress we expect from their starting points. Clearly if any of these areas are not secure it is essential that you attend parents evenings. I would add that there are many reasons why a child may not be making expected progress, the important thing is to be clear as a family and as a school of what we are doing to support pupils to progress and achieve.
