

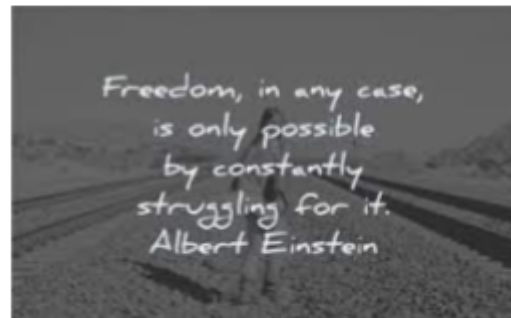
Collective Worship
