

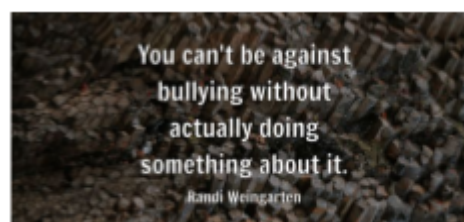
# Collective Worship
