Open Evening and Grammar School

Please make sure that all your friends are aware at St Michaels open evening is next Wednesday 5th October between 6-8pm.

We're delighted that St Michael's has grown in popularity and, although we are confident that we will be able to take all those who want to come to us in Year 5, things have become a little tighter at key stage 3. This is partly because several parents whose children passed the grammar school entrance exams last year chose to stay with us and we have also received over half a dozen pupils from the independent sector in the last few months. There may be many different reasons for this but we are encouraged that, increasingly, families are seeing the social and academic benefits that an excellent comprehensive education can offer. Whilst in the past it has been possible for families to try Grammar and come back to QE if their child hasn't taken to single sex schooling, the demand for places at QE means that they are now oversubscribed in every year group. Consequently, the decision to move out of the Wimborne Pyramid needs to be taken with even more care. We respect the right of parents to choose whatever they think is best for their child so if any of you are considering Grammar school in September please feel free to talk it through with me at school.
